
OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ECKVILLE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTROL AND OPERATION OF OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF ECKVILLE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 18 of the Off-Highway Vehicle Act, Chapter 0-4 RSA 1980, and amendments thereto Town Council deems it necessary to regulate and control the operation of Off-Highway Vehicles within the Town corporate limits, and:

WHEREAS, Council's intention is to allow an owner or operator of an Off-Highway Vehicle to travel on roadways, lanes and designated trails for the purpose of providing:

- a) a direct route of travel to areas outside of the Town limits as defined in Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
- b) a direct route of ravel from outside the Town limits to a pre-determined destination within the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Eckville duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. Off-Highway Vehicle" means any motorized vehicle designated for cross-country travel on land, snow, ice, marsh or swamp land or on other natural terrain.
2. No person shall operate an Off-Highway Vehicle between the hours of 2300 hour of any day and 0800 hour of the next day succeeding.
3. No person shall cause an Off-Highway Vehicle to operate in excess of twenty kilometres per hour.
4. All Off-Highway Vehicles are prohibited from the following areas: school areas, all park and recreation areas, cemetery, and sewage lagoon area.
5. A person who is guilty of an offense under this Bylaw is to be charged under Section 28 of the Off-Highway Vehicle Act.

This Bylaw rescinds Bylaw 566/94.

This Bylaw shall be in effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
